Designed to build upon Sundance's rustic elegance, the Snowbar aims to immerse guests in a unique mountain setting suggestive of a log cabin-type hideout. The space will be furnished with tables, chairs, benches sculpted out of snow, firepits and will feature western-style decor.

"It has been eye-opening to see so many different departments eagerly come together to transform this once-dream into a reality.
